Main Point:

Jesus is even more essential to our souls than food is to our physical bodies.



Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst."

Remember- Following Jesus is a Godordained dynamic tension of dependence and discipline. --saved by grace, but saved for good works --faith is childlike trust, yet we are expected to mature into adulthood. -- "work out your own salvation...for it is

God who works in you..." Philippians 2:12-13

1st application-

Come to Jesus regularly with a spiritual appetite of expectation- that he will give us both our daily spiritual bread and our daily physical well-being. 2nd application-

Contemplate the mystery and reality of Jesus' life (his incarnation & humanity) and ask Him to live through you. 3rd application-

Ask Jesus to expose your sinful desires, develop godly desires in you, and satisfy your deepest desires.
